

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
Tools Required: Drill, 1/8" bit, Phillips Screwdriver, Slotted Screwdriver. Optional: 7/16" open end or box end wrench.

NOTE: Use this instruction and hardware kit included with this 1382 McKenzie Cal-King Bookcase Headboard ONLY if you are using a Hollywood frame. IF you are using this product with Whittier Wood Furniture Footboard and Pedestal kits, disregard this instruction and hardware and use what is included with your Footboard kit.


Note: Assembly can be separated into three pieces for ease of maneuvering through narrow halls and stairways; if you need to perform this process see steps 7 through 11.

- 1. Remove the metal brackets attached to the Headboard (Ag).
- 2. Place the Headboard (Ag) against the end brackets of the frame and mark the locations for the screws. Drill pilot holes approximately 1-1/4" deep. To make sure you don't drill deeper, measure 1-1/4" up from the end of the drill bit and wrap a piece of tape around the bit. Stop drilling when the edge of the tape meets the wood.
- 3. Position the Headboard (Ag) against the frame and attach using six #14 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws (YG) and six Washers (ZK).
- 4. Place your bed in its final position. To level the headboard, reach behind the bookcase front legs and, using a slotted screwdriver, find the Large Adjustable Glide (YA). Using a slotted screw driver, rotate the Large Adjustable Glides (YA) clockwise until they bear weight. See Figures 4, 4a and 4b.

This is important if the bookcase headboard sits upon a carpet tack strip.




5. Open the Door (R). To adjust the brake tension on the Door Stay (ZE) turn the screw on the front of the Door Stay clockwise to loosen or counterclockwise to tighten. See Figures 5 and 5a.









6. Unwrap the False Bottoms (Sg) and place them on top of the rails in the Headboard Assembly (Ag). Make sure the finger holes face forward as shown in Figure 6. After you have placed your electronics inside the cubbies, use the Wire Clips (ZS) on the underside of the cubbies to secure the wires. Close the door tightly making sure the magnetic catches and plates securely touch.




7. To divide this larger unit into three sub-assemblies, start by removing the Top Assembly (XA). Remove the #6 x 5/8" Philtruss Screw (ZJ) and #8 Washer (YR) connecting the Backs to the Vertical Divider, and the #6 x 5/8" Philtruss Screws (ZJ) connecting the backs to the Top Assembly. Do not remove the Backs. See Figures 7 and 7a.




8. Figure 8 shows the locations of the screws that need to be removed. You can access these from the front of the unit. Remove the #8 x 1-3/8" Lo-Profile Screws (YJ) attaching the Sides and Vertical Dividers to the Top, and #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screws attaching the Front Apron to the Top. Carefully remove the Top Assembly (XA) from the Case. See Figures 8 and 8a.



9. Remove the #8 x 1-1/4" Pan Head Screw (ZN) connecting the Top Aprons. Open the Doors and remove the 1/4" x 1-1/2" Hex Bolts (YT) and 18mm Washers (ZK) See Figures 9, 9a and 9b.



10. Carefully separate the two halves of the Case Assembly. See Figures 10 and 10a.



11. After moving the headboard sections into your room reassemble the Headboard by reversing these steps.
